### ARIZONA

This letter is to inform you of the expiration dates of the Southern California Drywall/Lathing Master Agreement.

Drywall/Lathing Agreement "Article XXIII Term of Agreement" provides a window period at least 60 days but in no event, more than 90 days prior to June 30, 2006. This means that you have between March 31, and April 30, 2006 in which to submit in writing your desire to terminate the Agreement.

### CALIFORNIA

If you desire to terminate the Southern California Drywall/Lathing Master Agreement it would require written notice of your Company's withdrawal to Carpenters and the California Drywall/Lathing Conference of Western Wall & Ceiling Contractor Association, Inc. (See attached sample letters).

### NEVADA
