


MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Southwest Regional Council of Carpenters ("Union") and the Western Wall and Ceiling Contractors Association, Inc. ("Association") agree to amend the 2006-2012 Drywall/Lathing Master Agreement, Article XX, Section 6(h), to define the work of stocking and scrapping in accordance with industry practice. The following additional paragraph will be added to Article XX, Section 6(h):

"Stocking and scrapping is the placement and moving of materials at construction jobsites for work which falls within Article I of this Agreement, including the movement from the site of delivery on the job to the point of the job where the work is to be performed, moving materials at the job sites, disposal of scrap at the job sites, scraping of floors at the job sites, and doing general clean up work at the job sites. Stocker-scrappers shall at no time wear or use any tools of the trade, including, but not limited to, tool belts, pouches, screw guns, snips of any kind, saws of any kind, routers, power actuated tools, drywall knives, t-squares, plumb bobs, chalk lines, hammers, hatchets, or measure tapes. The only exception to the use of a tool would be the use of a knife, snips, or nippers to facilitate the opening of bundles or cartons of materials to be placed on the job site. They shall not do any type of construction work that is traditionally done by drywall/lathers and/or apprentice drywall/lathers."
