SUBJECT: Wage and Contribution Schedule

Following is the schedule of **Drywall Carpenters** wages and fringe benefit contributions for those Employers operating in Southern California who are bound to the Southern California Drywall/Lathing Master Agreement. Please note that these rates apply to **commercial** construction only.

A total increase of \$2.25 for work in Southern California **outside of San Diego** will be effective on July 1, 2007 and allocated as follows: \$1.90 to Wages, \$0.25 to Pension, \$0.10 to Supplemental Dues.
