#### **CEMENT MASONS**

It was voted on and approved to allocate the \$2.00 as follows for the Cement Masons: \$1.13 to the Wage, \$0.04 to Supplemental Dues, \$0.02 to International Dues, \$0.50 to the Pension, \$0.25 to Health & Welfare, \$0.05 to Local Training and \$0.01 to International Training.
